Many of you have signed up for the [ygrene training](#), so we thought it was a good idea to send you the link to that [website](#) as well as a brief summary for the Clean Energy Sacramento program.

Clean Energy Sacramento is a new financing opportunity for commercial and residential property owners in the City of Sacramento. Through this program, property owners can upgrade their properties - with energy-saving, water-saving or renewable energy improvements - with no up-front costs, paying back the financing through their property tax bills over periods of up to 20 years. Contractors can use this financing to sell more, larger clean energy projects.

To become certified for participation, contractors must join in a 1-day training course to gain knowledge about the program and how it works, access to its proprietary program management software, and sales success tips.

As you can see, there are two required courses (modules 1 and 2), which take a full day to complete. Module 3, Energy Pro, is recommended for any participant who does not have experience in this software - particularly on the commercial side, where it is typically required.
