Here are the highlights of the SMUD contractor meeting:

New Duplex /Quadplex Rebate:

The SMUD Home Performance Program has updated its guidelines regarding the eligibility of 2-4-unit buildings with natural gas or propane service. Specifically, duplexes, triplexes, and quadplexes with gas service are now eligible for rebates (half rebates for units under 1,000 square feet, full rebates for units 1,000 or larger). Specifically, Town home, condos, duplex, triplex and quadplex are now accepted as part of the HPP. New Updated JRT offers air sealing and air quality rebate

The JRT and rebate menu have been updated to offer a new installation measure: Air Sealing and Air Quality. This measure incentivizes air sealing throughout the home in addition to installing adequate continuous mechanical ventilation per ASHRAE standards. The new JRT was sent to contractors by email on April 30. You can download the current JRT [here](#).

SMUD Assessment documents June 30st deadline

Started June 2, the assessment subsidy has decreased to \$150. On September 2, this rate will decrease to a \$100 per assessment. The conversion rate of 20% still holds.

Also, a final reminder: There is a \$200 early adopter rebate bonus for customers for jobs whose post-upgrade documentation is submitted and complete before 5 PM on June 30, 2013. Any post-upgrade documentation submitted after June 30 will not receive the \$200 bonus, even if the

upgrade work was completed before that date. Please allow several days to make any corrections required prior to this deadline to ensure your customer receives the full rebate expected.
